Lent – a time for reflection

Lent, the 40 days leading up to Easter, is traditionally a time when people give things up, but have you ever considered *taking* something up for Lent?

Lent is the penitential season, when we prepare to remember again the death of Christ, and to celebrate his resurrection. As such, it a good time to reflect upon Jesus and upon our relationship with him. One way of helping us to do that is by using the word of God, by allowing God to speak to us afresh through his word, the Bible. St. John, in his Gospel, tells us why he wrote his Gospel:

³⁰ Jesus’ disciples saw him do many other miraculous signs in addition to the ones recorded in this book. ³¹ But these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that by believing in him you will have life by the power of his name. (John 20:30-31 NLT)
