Thank you so much for reaching out to our community.

We can talk...

- Listen to how they are feeling and what they are concerned about,
- Ask about the people they love,
- Chat about the small blessings each other have witnessed or experienced,
- Be open to listening (within reason) to people wanting to offload about more tricky things; financial worries, relationship struggles, spiritual big questions...

We can pray...

Ask: Can I pray for you?

- Yes please Set prayers to read out are on the second page The Lord's prayer could be
 prayed with folk together. Others you can suggest the person says 'Amen' at the end if they
 agree with it. You can also offer to pray extempore for specifics they've mentioned eg
 people, needs, thanksgiving, feelings, thoughts.
- No thank you would you like me to pray for you later about anything? Would you like me to add that to our list for our prayer team to pray for?

We can offer to...

Collect shopping and bring the receipt back, collect prescriptions, take letters to the post box. (encouragement for the less electronically connected)
