Wreath Making Zoom: Guidance and helps



What you need to purchase/gather ahead:

- 30cm metal wreath ring 30cms. £1.20 Aberkhan, £1.50 Aigburth Nurseries,
- Pair of secateurs or strong scissors
- A roll of florist's wire, used for continuous wrapping around the frame
- A couple of small oranges, thinly sliced and dried – see below
- Moss (can do without this, but wreath will last longer with it) £6 per bag from Aigburth Nurseries, which can cover 2 wreaths. May be available in other garden centres.
- Uhu glue. Currently only 99p in the hardware section of Home Bargains!

All of these items can also be found in other garden centres, discount stores and online.

What to gather on the day of the zoom:

- A collection of green seasonal foliage which can be gathered into small bunches e.g. pine, fir, ivy, leafy sprigs.
- Berries, red or white

Optional extras:

- Cinnamon sticks: 6-8 in 3 or 4 pairs, tied with string or ribbon
- Red ribbon
- Artificial berries
- Metal wreath hook or ribbon for hanging on your door
- Limes or lemons, dried – again see below
- Acorns or pine cones

How to dry your fruit:

1. Preheat the oven to 150°C, Fan 130°C, gas mark 2.
2. Slice into approx. 5-7mm deep rounds, avoiding thick wedges.
3. Pat each slice well in kitchen roll to absorb the juice.
4. Lay slices on greaseproof paper on a baking tray and heat on the middle shelf for 30mins.
5. Turn slices over, turn oven down to 100°C and dry for another 2hrs.
